HERE WE GO! 2024 IPMS National Competition PRE-REGISTRATIONS now open. Just fill out the basic form and submit. Things to note...

Pre-registration is required to enter the competition. Once you have submitted the form you will duly be emailed an exclusive competitor code. This code is to be used on each of your model entry forms (this should save you repeating your details). Entry forms will be available at a later date.

Pre-registration is needed for us, your host, to gauge numbers for the event and competition. The information you provide should be as accurate as you can genuinely predict at this time. We know that the modelling gods don't always smile upon us, and that circumstances can change in a brushstroke, so you will not be held strictly to the numbers and classes you indicate. Don't stress, best guesses will do.

<u>Pre-registrations will be open for a limited time only</u>*. Please don't leave it too late to submit your form. In the meantime, keep modelling!

Lockheed P-3K2 Orion NZ 4203

Over the extended weekend - 18 April to 21 April the RNZAF Air Force Museum's latest acquisition and in background storage, was opened to the general public for close-up inspection of the exterior of the aircraft.
